NOTE: The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare vide letter No.V-17020/2/2020-INI-II/FTS-8045229 dated 20th July, 2022 has created various posts for PGI Satellite Centre, Sangrur, Punjab and the candidates selected for these posts will be posted at PGI Satellite Centre, Sangrur, Punjab by the competent authority as per decision of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and they will not have any claim/right whatsoever for the posts at PGIMER, Chandigarh.

Out of 24 posts, 01(ONE) post of Assistant Professor in the department of Internal Medicine as being advertised is reserved for PwBD candidates with disabilities for B-Blind, LV-Low Vision.

A. BASIC DETAILS:-

- (iii) The last date of receipt of offline applications (hard copy) in the Recruitment Cell is **24.09.2022 till 01:00 P.M.**
- (iv) Candidates should ensure that they fulfill the eligibility criteria for the above noted posts. Candidates are required to download the application form and apply through the Institute website <u>www.pgimer.edu.in</u>. The candidates should have a **valid e-mail ID and Mobile**

No. which should be kept active during the recruitment process as the Call Letter & other information will be given to them through email/SMS only.

- (vi) The above vacancies are provisional and subject to variation. The competent authority reserves the right to vary the number of vacancies including reserved vacancies as per Govt. of India rules/circulars and the reservation will be followed as per Government of India rules.

B. IMPORTANT NOTE:-

 All information relating to this recruitment including addendum/Corrigendum/updates if any, Eligibility notice, subsequent schedule of interview and document verification and final result of selected candidates will be announced and displayed only on PGIMER's Website at <u>www.pgimer.edul.in</u>. Candidates will not be informed individually in this regard. Therefore, the candidates are advised to visit regularly on **PGIMER's website** for any updates. PGIMER will not be responsible for information from other sources.

C. AGE LIMIT:-

- Upper age limit shall be determined as on last date of submission of applications i.e. 24.09.2022.
- Date of Birth as recorded in the Matriculation/Secondary Examination Certificate only will be accepted for determining the age and no subsequent request for change will be considered or granted.
- No age relaxation would be available to reserved category candidates (SC/ST/OBC) applying for unreserved vacancy (UR/EWS).

- **NOTE: I.** Age relaxation prescribed for PwBD and departmental candidates i.e. Central Govt. Civilian Employees shall not be considered together and the age relaxation for only one category being more beneficial to the candidate will be allowed.
 - **II.** The maximum age of the applicant belonging to PwBD category after allowing the prescribed age relaxation **shall not exceed 56 years** on the crucial date.

D. SC/ST/OBC/PWBD/EWS CERTIFICATE:-

All candidates, irrespective of category may be considered against UR vacancies, subject to fulfillment of parameters for UR candidates. Reserved category (SC/ST/OBC) candidates availing age relaxation will not be considered for UR vacancies. However, against the vacancies earmarked for specific categories (SC/ST/OBC), only candidates belonging to that category will be considered.

Candidates applying under any of the reserved category posts, viz.SC/ST/OBC/PWBD/EWS will be considered subject to Caste/PWBD/EWS certificate issued by the appropriate/Competent Authority in the prescribed format. Community should be clearly and legibly mentioned in the Certificate.

E. OBC CANDIDATES:-

a) Candidates applying under OBC category must produce the valid caste certificate in the format provided by the DoPT vide O.M. No.36036/2/2013-Estt(Res.) dated 30.05.2014.

b) OBC candidate's eligibility will be based on the caste(s) borne in the Central List of Government of India.

c) The vacancies are being advertised in Financial year 2022-2023, therefore, valid NCL-OBC certificate issued after 01.04.2022 will be considered valid. Candidature who have NCL-OBC certificate issued before this period(i.e.01.04.2022) will not be considered valid for this advertisement. Therefore, OBC candidate must ensure that they have a valid OBC certificate on or before closing date of offline application i.e. 24.09.2022.

d) OBC candidate(s) should not belong to Creamy Layer and their sub-caste should match with the entries in Central List of OBC, failing which their candidature will not be considered for OBC post. They will however be treated as UR candidate(if UR posts advertised).

e) Candidates may also note in respect of the above that their candidature will remain provisional till the veracity of the concerned document is verified by the Appointing Authority.

F. EWS CANDIDATES:-

The candidates seeking reservation under EWS should fulfill the criteria as prescribed by Government of India (Office Memorandum F.No.36039/1/2019 dated 31st January 2019 by Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pension & F.No.A11013/01/2019 dated 28th February 2019 by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India) and not covered under the scheme of reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs and whose family has gross annual income below Rs. 8.00 lakh (Rupees eight lakh only) are to be identified as EWSs for benefit of reservation. Income shall also include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business, profession etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application.

Also persons whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWS, irrespective of the family income:-

- i. 5 acres of agricultural land and above;
- ii. Residential flat of 1000 sq. ft. and above;
- iii. Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities;
- iii. Residential plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than
 - the notified municipalities.

The property held by a "Family" in different locations or different places/cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS status.

The term "Family" for this purpose will include the person who seeks benefit of reservation, his/her parents and siblings below the age of 18 years as also his/her spouse and children below the age of 18 years.

The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an **Income and Asset Certificate issued by a Competent Authority**. The Income and Asset Certificate issued from 01.04.2022 to 24.09.2022 by prescribed authorities in the prescribed format shall only be accepted as proof of candidate's claim as belonging to EWS.

The crucial date for submitting the income and asset certificate shall be the closing date for submission of applications. The Institute shall verify the veracity of the Income and Asset certificate submitted by the candidate. If a candidate gets appointment on the basis of false claim of EWS, his/her services shall be terminated without assigning any further reasons and without prejudice to such further action as may be taken under provisions of the Indian Penal Code of fake/ false certificate. Candidates may also note in respect of the above that their candidature will remain provisional till the veracity of the concerned document is verified by the Appointing Authority.

Where any vacancy earmarked for EWS cannot be filled up due to non-availability of a suitable candidate belonging to EWS, such vacancies shall not be carried forward to the next recruitment year as backlog. **Hence, other category candidates are also**

allowed provisionally to apply for EWS posts subject to condition that they will be considered for EWS posts as UR candidate only if EWS category seat is otherwise not filled. However, there shall be no relaxations available which are otherwise permitted under their specific categories.

G. NOC CERTIFICATE:-

No Objection Certificate from the present employer (in case of candidates working Government/Semi or Quasi Government, Government enterprises or Government funded autonomous institutions) is mandatory otherwise, candidature will not be considered for the post. Therefore, candidates are requested to kindly submit the same while applying.

H. INSTRUCTION FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES CATEGORY (PWD):-

The following departments for which vacancies are being advertised have been identified suitable for benchmark disabilities as notified vide Notification dated 04.01.2021 by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India and four percent of vacancies in the cadre strength have been reserved for Persons with Benchmarked Disabilities and horizontal reservation will be provided.

As per provisions of the Rights of the Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, 4% reservation to Personal with Benchmark Disabilities (PWBD) will be provided as per instruction issued by the Government of India, Ministry of Personal, Public Grievances & Pensions, Deptt. Of Personnal & Training vide O.M. No. 36035/02/2017-Estt. (Res) dated 15th January, 2018. Out of total 24 posts of Assistant Professor being advertised, **01(ONE) post of Assistant Professor in the department of Internal Medicine is earmarked for Persons with Disabilities for candidates having disabilities of B-Blind, LV-Low Vision.** The reservation for PwBD is on horizontal basis.

The persons who suffer from not less than 40% of disability will only be eligible for the benefit of reservation and other relaxations under PWD category as permissible under the rules. The applicant must have a valid Disability Certificate issued from the competent authority i.e. Medical Board duly constituted by the Central or the State Government. Certificates issued by the Medical Practitioner, Hospital or any other Institution will not be considered. The physical disability of finally selected candidates would be ascertained by a Medical Board of the Institute specifically constituted for this purpose.

As per para 4.1 of DOPT instructions dated 15.01.2018, in the category of posts which are identified suitable for persons with benchmark disabilities, a person with benchmark disability cannot be denied the right to compete for appointment by direct recruitment against an unreserved vacancy. Thus a person with benchmark disability can be appointed by direct recruitment against vacancy not specifically reserved for the persons with benchmark disability, provided the post is identified suitable for persons with benchmark disability of the relevant category.
