Reservations for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PWD candidates will be followed as per Govt. norms. If sufficient Engineering Graduates are NOT attending / joining the apprenticeship, the vacant positions will be engaged with Diploma holders and vice versa.

- AGE LIMIT:** Maximum age of 25 years or less as on 31/12/2022. Upper age limit is relaxed by 5 years for SC/ST, 3 years for OBC-NC & 10 years for PWD candidates.
- APPRENTICESHIP PERIOD:** The tenure of the Apprenticeship would be One year only which will commence from 2nd January 2023.
- ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION & ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

Candidates who have passed four years B.E/ B.Tech course in the above mentioned engineering branches on or after 1st April 2020, from AICTE approved colleges / recognized Indian Universities for GEA. In case of Diploma Apprentices, the candidates who have passed 3 Years Diploma course in above mentioned branches on or after 1st April, 2020.

5. How to Apply:

Eligible Candidates should apply through ECIL online portal at careers.ecil.co.in Enrollment in the NATS portal (www.mhrdnats.gov.in.) is mandatory for apprenticeship at ECIL Hyderabad.

6. METHOD OF SELECTION:

Apprentices selections will be done based on the qualifying examination marks merit. (i.e BE/B.Tech consolidated marks merit for GEAs and Diploma consolidated marks for Diploma Apprentices). In case of CGPA, relevant CGPA to marks percentage conversion certificate from the college/university should be produced by the candidate.

7. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- a) Before applying, candidate should read the advertisement carefully and ensure that he / she has fulfilled eligibility criteria stated in the advertisement in all respects.
- b) The Degree of Disability for PWD Candidates is 40% & above.
- c) All qualifications should be from Indian Institutes recognized by Appropriate Statutory Authority.
- d) The application is liable for rejection at any stage of recruitment process in case of suppression of facts/ furnishing of false information.

The Apprentice after completion of the training shall have no right to claim any employment in ECIL.
- m) ECIL being highly protected establishment, Selected Apprentices should produce the following documents at the time of joining: i) Character /Conduct certificate from the concerned institution where they last studied. ii) Police verification certificate from concerned District Police Superintendent. iii) A physical fitness certificate from a Civil Assistant Surgeon.
